## Advocacy Update from Wisconsin

FSPHP once again partnered with the Wisconsin Medical Society (WisMed) last week in supporting legislation that will allow Wisconsin to join 47 other states in creating a Health Professional Assistance Program (HPAP) - an important resource for physicians and other health care professionals.

FSPHP President-Elect **Edwin Kim, MD, FAPA** and WisMed Chief Value and Engagement Officer and FSPHP Member **Jim Lorence** testified together in front of the Senate Committee on Mental Health, Substance Abuse Prevention, Children and Families in strong support of [Senate Bill 802](#), which supports the creation of such an HPAP. The program would assist health care professionals who seek help for behavioral health issues.

Terrance has been an extraordinary leader and advocate for physician health and well-being for decades, leaving an enduring legacy that has shaped the culture of support within our profession.


As Vice President of the **Medical Society of the State of New York** and Executive Director of the **Committee for Physician Health** since 1997, Terrance has guided countless physicians and advanced physician health initiatives across New York and beyond. A longtime **Board member** and **past Treasurer of the FSPHP**, he pioneered the early growth of our organization with his wisdom, administrative leadership, and unwavering vision.

Complementing his physician health leadership, Terrance volunteered as a Class A Trustee of a recovery program's General Service Board (GSB) in New York City, serving as Treasurer before his Chairmanship from 2013-2017. During this tenure, he advanced strategic outreach to foster hope in diverse communities, ensured governance stability amid transitions, and provided fiscal oversight to reinforce the program's principles of recovery, unity, and selfless service—efforts chronicled in newsletters like the [Summer 2013 issue](#) featuring his appointment and the [July 2017 Quarterly Report reflecting his legacy](#).

Terrance's distinguished healthcare career spans over four decades, from U.S. Army Medical Service Corps service to executive roles at Beekman Downtown Hospital, St. Joseph Mercy Hospital in Michigan, and as President/CEO of Myers Community Hospital near Rochester, New York. His board service includes the Hospital Association of New York State (HANYS), Rochester Regional Hospital Association, and appointment by Chief Judge Judith Kaye as a charter member of the Lawyers Assistance Trust, overseeing substance abuse programs for attorneys and judges.

We celebrate Terrance for elevating standards of well-being, recovery, and accountability for those who care for others. His contributions will inspire future generations of physician health leaders.

On behalf of the FSPHP Board and membership, we thank Terrance for his decades of remarkable service, leadership, and friendship. We wish him a fulfilling retirement, confident his influence endures.
