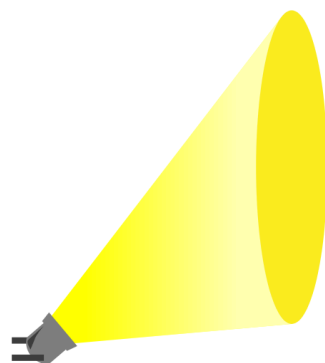
The FSPHP-ETA™ program will encourage consistency and quality improvement among providers who work with this safety-sensitive population.

The FIGS Awesome Humans Foundation is now accepting applications for grants and scholarships that support healthcare professionals.

Through four distinct grants (and more to come), the Foundation will meet Awesome Humans where they are:

- **Rapid Relief for Awesome Humans** – Fast, flexible financial support when life takes an unexpected turn.



Open year-round to those who live or study within the U.S.

- **Future Icons Grant** – \$10,000 scholarships to help tomorrow’s healthcare leaders focus on what really matters. *Applications open December 2, 2025 - February 28, 2026. Open to those who live or study within the U.S.*
- **Ubuntu Grant** – Funding for mission-aligned nonprofits building innovative programs that strengthen and support healthcare professionals. *Applications open July 1, 2026 - August 31, 2026. Open to U.S. and registered international non-profits.*
- **Healthcare is Human Award** – Honoring those changing the system from within through courage, leadership, and advocacy.
