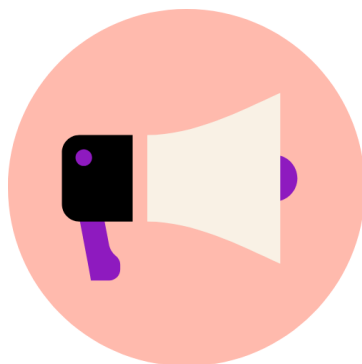
Membership Renewal Notifications Coming October 1

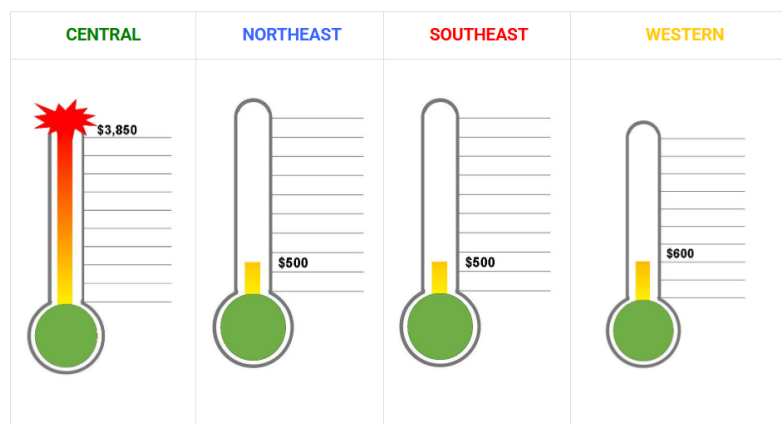
