The Kentucky Physicians Health Foundation is currently welcoming applications for the position of Medical Director.

Kentucky Physicians Health Foundation (KPHF) is a nonprofit organization whose mission is the identification, evaluation and treatment of substance use disorders and mental health issues, and reentry and advocacy for professionals who are licensed by the Kentucky Board of Medical Licensure (KBML). KPHF is a confidential resource for professionals to the extent provided by the statutes of the state of Kentucky.

The Medical Director shall be employed by and serve under the direction of the Board of Directors, Kentucky Physicians Health Foundation, Inc as stated in the Articles of Incorporation. In addition, he/she shall hold other responsibilities as directed by the Board of Directors and as indicated by the dictates of the Foundation's activities.

The Medical Director shall hold a current active medical license in the Commonwealth of Kentucky or acquire such. He/She shall have demonstrated leadership, knowledge and experience in the treatment of substance use disorders and mental health issues.

The Medical Director shall develop and maintain a close relationship with the Kentucky Board of Medical Licensure and staff. The Medical Director shall attend all scheduled KBML Board and Disciplinary panels and interact with the Board on all issues of mutual concern.

The Medical Director shall respond to all concerns, questions or information received from various sources regarding the suspected impairment of an individual who is licensed by the Kentucky Board of Medical Licensure.

The Medical Director shall meet with those individuals who are determined to need an assessment. Following the assessment, the Medical Director will be responsible for deciding the appropriate course of action and progress plan.

He/She shall also communicate to the individual the plan and expectations and respond in accordance with the statutes of the state of Kentucky.

The Medical Director shall act as an advocate on behalf of individuals with which the Foundation has a relationship.

The Medical Director shall work to develop and expand relationships with appropriate facilitators for evaluations, treatment and aftercare.

The Medical Director shall promote the work of the Foundation through providing education and speaking engagements to hospitals, universities/colleges, other licensing boards and appropriate organizations.

The Medical Director shall meet and maintain all requirements and responsibilities listed in the “Medical Director Employment Agreement” and any other pertinent KPHF documents.

The Medical Director shall seek new potential donors to the Foundation and actively participate in all fund-raising efforts.

The Medical Director shall report directly to and routinely interact with the President/Chairman of the Board of Directors of the KPHF as well as other members of the Board.
